

Religion has always nauseated me because it is a covering that puts man over man and glorifies man instead of God. But divine love projects the Lord.

In our local newspaper a few weeks ago there was a picture and an article of a man selling coffins on the side of the local highway. He didn't want to remain on the dole so he wanted to make low cost coffins for those who wanted a cheap funeral. So he was making these cheap coffins out of Macracarpa wood and he was selling them for \$150 instead of paying 3 or 4 grand. Well, we have got plenty of hard up people who cannot afford expensive coffins, so he had a good market for them.

Anyway, in the same newspaper article there was this fellow being measured up by this same man on the side of the road for a coffin and he was in the sad predicament of knowing he was going to die soon. Now he had a Zimmer walking- frame with oxygen tank on it with hoses in his nose to help him breathe because he had been smoking all his life and has emphysema.

A few days after this newspaper article, I was at my son's joinery workshop on a Saturday morning. We had just built a specialty kitchen and he's got all these wood off-cuts from its construction and I decided to load them onto his utility truck and take them home for firewood. Beside his workshop is another business and I did not know at that time that this coffin maker was temporarily using this business to build these coffins.

So here I was loading up the truck with the off cuts and there, about thirty feet away was this same man who had been measured up for a coffin in the newspaper article standing in a vertical coffin that had just been built for him, and around him was a crowd of newspaper photographers and journalists. And I looked and I said within myself "what a stupid thing to be doing".

Now, I'm an opportunist and you've got to be an opportunist too if you want to successfully serve the Lord. You take opportunities to bring people to Christ. If you want to get rid of complexes in your life, then step into the shoes of those worse off than yourself and life will get some substance to it.

So I stopped loading the truck and went up and asked the photographer and the journalist what the great attraction was with this man standing in the coffin and they said that they wanted to do another article on him now that he has bought what he was measured up for. Now this man has got on a black leather jacket and long hair, probably been in the 'Hells Angels' or something like that and he's just a ruffian to look at. Now, I've got a good sense of humour, but I can be straight too. So I said to the journalist "look mate send that fellow to me when you have finished your interview"

Well, anyway, they soon finished taking their pictures and this guy comes down on his zimmer walking frame and I asked him "are you going in that box?" He said, "Yep, I'm dying." I think that is amazing when a person has that attitude of flippancy towards dying. It doesn't go down well with me.

Now most people out in the world put on a brave face of bluff. They are scared out of their wits much like how Brother Branham spoke about America 'They are whistling through the graveyard pretending not to be scared'. They know this world is shot. Men's hearts are failing for fear. Every man and woman on this earth are frightened of what's coming on the earth.

I said to this fellow "You had better come in to the workshop, which he did and he sat down on his walking frame seat while I pulled up another chair. Then I said to him "are ready to meet the Lord mate?" His reply was "no I'm not. I can't sleep at night because I've done so many things wrong. He had a very long list of evil things he had done in his life. He was a ruffian in his past and to look at him he was the opposite of being a ballerina. My purpose is to show that we are here to project love and to be the way the Lord made you in doing this. I said "do you want to give your heart to the Lord? He said, 'No, I'm not ready'. I said, it will only take you thirty seconds. And do you know what he did? He just grabbed my hands, straight off. I said, 'Let's pray, mate. I prayed for him, and then he said 'Lord, forgive me of all I have done.' And he got up and shook my hands, gave me a bear hug and soon after left the shop to get into a vehicle that had a trailer behind it with his coffin on. God is good! He's got an appointment with me later on. I come from a family of absolute heathens. No Christianity in it at all. I'm just an elect seed out of a whole lot of darkness'. My family has made fun of the things of God and it was hard being raised in that kind of environment. Years ago I read in the Book of Acts that the shadow of the disciples passing over the sick would bring healings and one day I would like to see this happen. Visit to Zimbabwe & Mozambique

The Groombridge Convention & Missions

The school hall at Groombridge Primary School, Harare, Zimbabwe was packed with believers and ministers from eight countries worshipping together for five days of August this year.

Harare itself is a walled city. Not walled as in ancient times when a wall surrounded a city for protection from outsiders, but a city where every property is walled as protection from others in the same city. It seemed strange to be on streets where no homes but only prison like walls could be seen. Even the few new homes being built today have the same high walls and barbed wire protection. Groombridge school hall, however, was readily visible and easily accessible.



Slow African start to the Convention

The Groombridge Conventions, run by Pastor Albert Matimbe of Harare, had been a success for several years and the 2013 event was no different with believers from South Africa, Zambia, Mozambique, Malawi, and Uganda attending as well as churches from the hosting nation Zimbabwe. There was also Pastor Rolf Strommen from Norway and myself from New Zealand as additional speakers. With some thirty Pastors in attendance the variety and choice of presenters was immense.



People just kept coming

The Convention, held between the 9th and 13th of August, provided food and accommodation for those from other countries. I was fortunate enough to be billeted with the Durands, an older ex farming couple who now had sons in New Zealand. Three services a day, except the last day, meant we were generally at the convention site for up to 12 hours a day, but we were well catered for and there was plenty of time to get to know other ministers and believers in an informal setting.

There were gems and nuggets of gold in every sermon preached but I was particularly struck by Brother Rolf Strommen of Norway's sermons on the third generation linking the falling away after Joshua died to the Message today after Brother Branham's death. John Kyakonye's (Uganda) timely reminder that "although Brother Branham has gone Christ hasn't" hit home for many. Linking again with my old friend Pastor Samuel Otaget (also from Uganda) and hearing him preach was an extra bonus for me.

When the call came to speak at this convention I was troubled because of the key subject I felt led to preach on. On past visits to Africa (and in other countries too) I had noticed a reliance on the pastor for everything. That forcibly reminded me of Israel's determination to have a king in 1 Samuel 8. People seemed to want the minister to pray for them, fight their battles for them and tell them what to do instead of individually following the leading of the Holy Spirit. God told Samuel that the people hadn't rejected him but they had rejected God. Wasn't this also exactly the same problem in the church ages? Men organised things and left out the leadership of the Holy Spirit. Added to this there were Pastors acting like King Saul, hurling spears of accusations against young Davids in the congregation. Other "want to be pastors" were preparing to start their own kingdom by taking people from the church they were currently in. This is the Absalom spirit. He had sat in the Kings gate winning the hearts of the people. Then there were Ishmaelite people who were only interested in finances and would buy and sell the souls of men just to get an income. They were only pastors so they could make a living or get financial gain.

With this and much more on my heart, I faced the convention of over 200 souls, with some thirty Pastors sitting behind me on the stage, in some trepidation.

African people tend to be more tribal or family-minded than the often more selfish and individualistic western people. What I felt led to say could easily be seen by both Pastors and Congregation as an attack on them and their culture.

I should have known better. The “Amen’s” and “Hallelujah’s” confirmed that this was not a message against those attending this convention but was support for them as they faced others who had those problems. I trust that these types and patterns helped them to correct others in love, wanting only to bring those in error back to a better relationship with Christ.

In other sermons, such as the Blood Line, the Melchisedec High Priest and Motive and Objective, I got into the habit of acting out parts and getting people up on stage to illustrate points. For example having three pastors representing the Father, Son and Holy Ghost standing there a pace or two apart and then applying such scriptures to them as Isaiah 9 v6, where the Son is called the Everlasting Father, Isaiah 43 v11 where God the Father claims to be the only Saviour and Matthew 1 v18 the Holy Spirit is named the Father of Jesus revealed the trinity doctrine as totally unscriptural. This and other teaching techniques seemed to go down very well and added to the colourful variety of preaching styles at the convention.

I was due to cross the border to Mozambique on Friday 16 August and had one day, the Thursday, free. The Durands took me on a mini safari where I saw a good part of the countryside and various animals. I was even able to stroke a lion and ride an elephant. Doing the reverse seemed dangerous!

John Kyakonye had wanted to visit Mozambique but as he said himself he was scared to go alone so asked if he could accompany me. Pastor Pedro Charles Alacandra, the organiser of my visit to Mozambique welcomed the chance of a second preacher so, much to my relief, I didn’t have to travel alone from Harare to the border town of Magimbe.

Pastor Pedro Charles and his team were on the Mozambique side of the border and we headed off to Vanduzi, a small town about an hour and a half from the border. And this is where the difference between the convention and tour became obvious. In Zimbabwe we preached in one place. In Mozambique we would travel a lot, staying at Vanduzi, Chimoio, Maringue, Savane and Dondo with four services in most places. John and I shared most of the services. These churches all had smaller congregations than the convention but that made things far more intimate. Instead of a modern hall we met in brick and plaster churches, a temporary wooden and polythene structure, plus a thatched, mud and wattle building.

The church in Maringue is in a refugee area and while it seemed to me that Mozambique was a poorer country than Zimbabwe these people must be the poorest of all. They have one small mud and wattle thatched hut to live in for each family, yet they smile with the joy of knowing the Message and the love of God.

There were times of contrasting emotions. Except for a couple of occasions there was never any hot water but when I found a hotel I had previously visited that had significantly dropped it’s standards, not even having running water for toilets and showers I lost my cool. The place was managed with a “so what” attitude. For a hospitality business this was not good and I complained loudly, not so much for the conditions but because of the lazy attitude and lack of motivation on the part of the owners to make something of their business.

In contrast the attitude of all the Pastors I worked with is excellent. Vanduzi and Chimoio are planning new churches and have purchased ground. Both Savane and Dondo have worked hard, laying concrete floors and upgrading roofs and generally improving their church buildings since my previous visit two years ago. Maringue church is in a refugee camp and although of simple construction the church was in good condition.

My pet hate is of electronic keyboards played at full volume over a PA system out of tune with the singing congregation. This was rarely an issue in Mozambique as either; the player was musical, or there was no electricity at the church!

As well as preaching God's message I was able, as a retired small business advisor, to pass on some business tips to several people. These people are very poor and if they can start and run a business they have hope. One key lesson I taught was a business's money had to be kept separate and not used tribally. There are many good business ideas but they are often only short term, or the customer base is too poor to make the idea viable.

Finally, I stopped over in Perth, Western Australia, on the way home to New Zealand. Long time NZ Message believers Eugene and Fleur Nahi allowed me plenty of rest. I preached twice at their new home church, the South Perth Eagle Fellowship, where I met with some other old friends from New Zealand and some new ones from Australia.

Smaller churches in Africa, especially those outside the capital and major cities which is where I tend to go, are very grateful to receive visiting ministries that preach the message without "special" doctrines. Just like all of us they like to feel that they too are part of the world wide Bride of Jesus Christ. These smaller churches frequently request return visits. For Perth to request the same gave me a confidence boost. The financial support they also gave toward the debt incurred in these missions was very generous and I would publicly like to thank them.

I thoroughly enjoyed my trip. I learnt a lot from so many different pastors at the Groombridge Convention making many new friends and it was a joy to meet with the central Mozambique ministry again. Praise God for His wonderful people throughout the world alive with His Holy Spirit.

UPDATE FROM HOMA BAY, KENYA

Dear Brother Richard,

Greetings to you. It was so good hearing from you. My heart is so much deep in our own people here in the lake region to receive the good message God has opened my eyes to. Denominations do not want to hear anything of it. They have already accused me of being a devil worshipper and some say the message churches worldwide are a cult and that Brother William Branham was killed in a road accident while driving drunk with alcohol.

Last week on 31 July I was expelled from being a member and the secretary general of Homa-Bay pastors fellowship. My church which I have served faithfully for several years excommunicated me stopped my monthly allowance and stopped paying school fees for my own children. The Catholic Church which was supporting our school and children home withdrew their support because I did refuse to allow them to baptize the children; we had also stopped sending our children to their morning prayers as it had been before.

We have met the last three Sundays with four sisters and three brothers in our home where we started the new end time message church. I have moved from pastoring over one hundred people to nine saints including my wife and myself.

My wife and I have looked back and we have been praying more to see if we are missing Gods divine direction for our lives. There is a lot of peace in our heart. The end time message is true. We cannot blame the people who do not understand it today. Tomorrow our heavenly father will open up their eyes to see the light. The end time message was revealed to me so it will be revealed to them.

I can not pretend that I have not heard from God. I heard Him clearly. His voice is that I go a head with His revelation. To me God is much bigger than the denominations, the monthly allowance given to my family and the funding from the catholic church to the school and orphans home started by wife and I.I can not trade all these with the revelation God has given to me concerning the servant of God, Prophet William Branham. His teachings are true. God has opened my eyes on **Malachi 4:5-6**, baptism, God head and the place of women in ministry. We want to stand with God and His word. We believe our former church was and is not our provider. The Catholic Church was and is not the source for the orphaned children under our care. GOD IS. All others are just instruments. He will open for us another door.

Brother Richard pray for us. Encourage us. Stand with us. I have never been criticised this much. We have lost almost all our friends in ministry because of the false rumours out there is that we have entered a devil worship cult. All these are done even to our own children in their schools. We asked our children if ever they have seen any devil in our house and they said NO. They are saying they see more of God in me than before. The church members in our new church who knew me before say they have never seen me preach in the manner before. That is what the devil wants to destroy. Jesus will remain my only true friend and the end time message will be the reason for me to wake up every morning. We were baptized wrongly. This week on Saturday we will have a re-baptism in the name of the Lord Jesus. Please put us into prayer. The good Lord keep you and be with you as I remain to hear from you. Please as you requested, you are free to put my testimony and prayer in your website. Pass our greetings to Pastor Greg.


Praise God that neither He nor His truly born-again children are perverts. Certainly, the devil is a pervert, and also his children – religious or otherwise!

Radio Outreach Testimonies...

In follow up to last month's article that featured the amazing determination and zeal of our dear Sister Mia, I am so thrilled to share with you that hearts and souls in Indonesia are being reached with the Truth.

These testimonies are the fruits of the radio broadcast that was made possible in part by the immense sacrifices made by those like Sister Mia. It was her gift that helped launch the radio broadcast in the city of Bandung.

The believers in Indonesia are doing personal, local follow-up, and are also utilizing modern social internet networks for support. On Face Book alone, there have been 162 responders who requested more material. Indonesians living on remote islands of Indonesia as well as those working in Hong Kong, Malaysia, and Brunei, have made contact via the international radio streaming found on the **Maestro Radio** station website.

Willy and Darwin are just two of many faithful local listeners. Willy made contact to say how immensely blessed and strengthened he was by the series of sermons on the original sin and the power of the new birth. He asked for more information and books and CD's were promptly sent. Darwin too shared how blessed he was by that same series of meetings and how tremendous it was to realize that God had sent a Prophet in these last days to confirm His Word. Not all responders though are so positive. One lady who had heard the radio broadcast immediately wrote to criticize Brother Itok, stating she believed he was leading the people astray.
